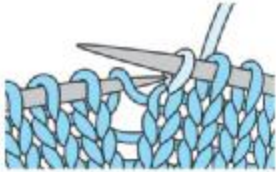


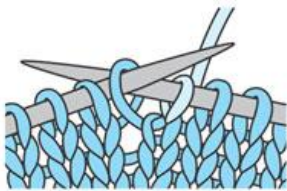
Mystery Sock KAL Part 4

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Make One Stitch Left (M1L)

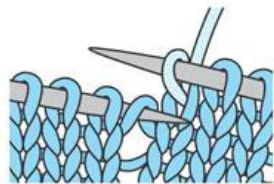


Slip the left-hand needle under the horizontal bar located between two stitches, **from front to back**. Notice how this “new” stitch is twisted.

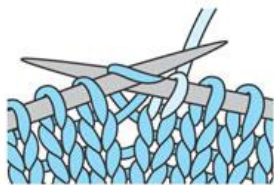


With the right-hand needle, knit through the back loop of this stitch. You’ve increased one stitch.

Make One Stitch Right (M1R)



Slip the left-hand needle under the horizontal bar located between two stitches, **from back to front**.



Then knit through the front as usual.

skp: slip 1 stitch as if to knit/knit the next stitch/then pass the slipped stitch over the knitted stitch and off the needle.

Wrap and Turn (w&t)

On a **KNIT** Row: Slip next stitch as if to purl with yarn in back; bring yarn forward between the needles (except when working the first w&t; here bring the yarn forward around the slipped stitch). Move the slipped stitch back to the left hand needle and move yarn to the back away from you, between the needles. TURN work (WS faces you now) and work the next (WS) row.

On a **PURL** Row: Slip next stitch as if to purl with yarn in front; bring yarn to the back of work between the needles (except when working the first w&t; here bring the yarn to back around the slipped stitch). Move the slipped stitch back to the left hand needle and move yarn to the front toward you, between the needles. TURN work (RS faces you now) and work the next (RS) row.

Leg will measure approx 6 3/4 (7, 7 1/4)" from rolled cast on edge.

Ankle Decrease

Small

Rnd 1

Row 1 (16"): (K11, P1, P2tog) twice. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24"): (K11, P3) twice. Rep for second sock.

(54 sts total per sock; 26 sts/16", 28 sts/24")

Rnd 2

Row 1 (16"): (K2tog, K2, YO, K3, YO, K2, skp, P2) twice. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24"): (K2tog, K2, YO, K3, YO, K2, skp, P3) twice. Rep for second sock.

Rnd 3

Row 1 (16"): (K11, P2) twice. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24"): (K11, P3) twice. Rep for second sock.

Rnd 4

Row 1 (16''): (K2tog, K1, YO, K5, YO, K1, skp, P2) twice. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): (K2tog, K1, YO, K5, YO, K1, skp, P3) twice. Rep for second sock.

Medium

Rnd 1

Row 1 (16''): (K2, K2tog, K7, P1, P2tog) twice, K9. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): P2tog, P1, P2tog, K11, P3, K9, K2tog, P3. Rep for second sock.

(63 sts total; 33 sts/16" needle, 30 sts/24" needle)

Rnd 2

Row 1 (16''): (K2tog, K1, YO, K3, YO, K2, skp, P2) twice, K2tog, K2, YO, K3, YO, K2tog. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): P3, K2tog, K2, YO, K3, YO, K2, skp, P3, K2tog, K2, YO, K3, YO, K1, skp, P3. Rep for second sock.

Rnd 3

Row 1 (16''): (K10, P2tog) twice, K5, K2tog, K2. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): P3, K11, P3, K10, P3. Rep for second sock.

(60 sts total; 30 sts/16" needle, 30 sts/24" needle)

Rnd 4

Row 1 (16''): (K2tog, YO, K5, YO, K1, skp, P1) twice, K2tog, K5, YO, K1. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): P3, K2tog, K1, YO, K5, YO, K1, skp, P3, K2tog, K1, YO, K5, YO, skp, P3. Rep for second sock.

Large

Rnd 1

Row 1 (16''): (K2, K2tog, K7, P1, P2tog) twice, K9. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): K2tog, P3, (K11, P3) twice. Rep for second sock.

(65 sts total; 33 sts/16" needle, 32 sts/24" needle)

Rnd 2

Row 1 (16''): (K2tog, K1, YO, K3, YO, K2, skp, P2) twice, K2tog, K2, YO, K3, YO, K2tog. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): K1, (P3, K2tog, K2, YO, K3, YO, K2, skp) twice, P3. Rep for second sock.

Rnd 3

Row 1 (16''): (K10, P2) twice, K5, K2tog, K2. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): K1, P3, (K11, P3) twice. Rep for second sock.

(64 sts total per sock; 32 sts per needle)

Rnd 4

Row 1 (16''): (K2tog, YO, K5, YO, K1, skp, P2) twice, K2tog, K5, YO, K1. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): K1, (P3, K2tog, K1, YO, K5, YO, K1, skp) twice, P3. Rep for second sock.

Gusset Increases

Small

Rnd 5

Row 1 (16''): K1, K1f&b, (K1, P1) to last 2 sts, K1f&b, K1. Rep for second sock. Turn. (28 sts)

Row 2 (24''): (K11, P3) twice. Rep for second sock.

Rnd 6

Row 1 (16''): K2, (P1, K1) to end. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): (K2tog, YO, K7, YO, skp, P3) twice. Rep for second sock. T

Rnd 7

Row 1 (16''): K1, M1R, (K1, P1) to last st, M1L, K1. Rep for second sock. Turn. (30 sts)

Row 2 (24''): (K11, P3) twice. Rep for second sock.

Rnd 8

Row 1 (16''): K3, (P1, K1) to last st, K1. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): K2, skp, P3, K2tog, K3, YO, K1, YO, K3, skp, P3, K2tog, K3, YO, K1, YO, K1. Rep for second sock.

Medium

Rnd 5

Row 1 (16''): K1, K1f&b, (K1, P1) to last 2 sts, K1f&b, K1. Rep for second sock. Turn. (32 sts)

Row 2 (24''): P3, K11, P3, K10, P3. Rep for second sock.

Rnd 6

Row 1 (16''): K2, (P1, K1) to end. Rep for second sock. **Turn.**

Row 2 (24''): P3, K2tog, YO, K7, YO, skp, P3, K2tog, YO, K7, YO, K1, P3. Rep for second sock. (31 instep sts)

Rnd 7

Row 1 (16''): K1, M1R, (K1, P1) to last st, M1L, K1. Rep for second sock. Turn. (34 sts)

Row 2 (24''): P3, K11, P3, K4, K2tog, K5, P3. Rep for second sock. Turn. (30 instep sts)

Rnd 8

Row 1 (16''): K3, (P1, K1) to last st, K1. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): K1, YO, K1, YO, K3, skp, P3, K2tog, K3, YO, K1, YO, K2,skp, P3, K2tog, K5. Rep for second sock.

Large

Rnd 5

Row 1 (16''): K1, K1f&b, (K1, P1) to last 2 sts, K1f&b, K1. Rep for second sock. Turn. (34 sts)

Row 2 (24''): **Row 2 (24'')**: K1, P3, (K11, P3) twice. Rep for second sock.

Rnd 6

Row 1 (16''): K2, (P1, K1) to end. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): K1, P3, (K2tog, YO, K7, YO, skp, P3) twice. Rep for second sock.

Rnd 7

Row 1 (16''): K1, M1R, (K1, P1) to last st, M1L, K1. Rep for second sock. Turn. (36 sts)

Row 2 (24''): K1, P3, (K11, P3) twice. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Rnd 8

Row 1 (16''): K3, (P1, K1) to last st, K1. Rep for second sock. Turn.

Row 2 (24''): K2, (YO, K1, YO, K3, skp, P3, K2tog, K3) twice, K2. Rep for second sock.

Leg will measure approx 7 1/4 (7 1/2, 7 3/4)" from rolled cast on edge.

Begin Short Rows

The short row heel is worked back and forth in rows on the 16" needle only. If you need an aid, place point protectors on each tip of 24" needle before you begin.

Unless otherwise specified, sl all st pw.

All Sizes

Sock 1

Row 1 (RS): Knit to last st, w&t.

Row 2 (WS): Purl to last st, w&t.

Row 3: Knit to last 2 sts, w&t.

Row 4: Purl to last 2 sts, w&t.

Row 5: Knit to last 3 sts, w&t.

Row 6: Purl to last 3 sts, w&t.

Row 7: Knit to last 4 sts, w&t.

Row 8: Purl to last 4 sts, w&t.

Cont to work w&t patt, wrapping 1 new st in each row, until a total of 11 (12, 13) sts have been wrapped on both sides. [8 (10, 10) sts rem unwrapped in middle section]

Unwrapping Short Rows

All Sizes

Row 1 (RS): Knit across middle section to first wrapped st. With yarn in back, PU wrap on LH needle by slipping RH needle from the bottom up through wrap. Leave wrap sitting on RH needle and knit the st that was wrapped; then pass wrap over st and off needle. Next st w&t (it will now be wrapped twice!).

Row 2 (WS): Purl across middle section to first wrapped st. With yarn in front, **PU wrap on RS of work (facing away from you!)** by slipping RH needle from bottom up through wrap. Leave wrap sitting on RH needle and purl st that was wrapped; pass wrap over st and off needle. Next st, w&t.

From now on, you will PU 2 wraps for each st, work and pass wraps over st and off needle.

Row 3: Knit across middle section to wrapped st. With yarn in back and RH needle, PU wraps on LH needle and knit the st that was wrapped; then pass wraps over st and off needle. Next st w&t.

Rep rows 2 and 3 until all (double) wrapped sts have been worked, ending with row 2.

Abbreviations

Approx: approximately, **beg:** begin(ning), **CO:** cast on, **cn:** cable needle, **cont:** continue, **g:** grams, **K:** knit, **K1f&b:** knit 1 stitch front and back, **LH:** left hand, **mm:** millimeters, **P:** purl, **patt:** pattern, **PU:** Pick up, **pw:** purlwise, **rep:** repeat(s), **RH:** right hand, **rnd(s):** round(s), **RS:** right side, **sl:** slip, **st(s):** stitch(es), **St st:** stockinette stitch, **WS:** wrong side, **wyib:** with yarn in back, **yds:** yards.
